General Admission Deadline (Enrollment)

Monday, July 15th, 2024 through Tuesday, October 31st, 2024.

ATTENTION - The enrollment pass is only valid after payment of the tuition and ÖH fees



ÖH-fee and tuition fees

For the payment of the ÖH-fee and/or tuition fees, you will be given or sent a one-time payment slip (after admission to studies/enrollment) in the study department. From the second semester on, you will no longer receive a payment slip. You will find the data for the fee to be paid on your own ufg-account.

The tuition fee must be paid as soon as possible, otherwise you will not be enrolled and will not be able to continue your studies. Furthermore, the entitlement to a scholarship is linked to the enrollment, i.e. the tuition fee. The scholarship office receives the enrollment data from the BRZ Vienna, which manages this data.



Counseling offered by the ÖH

A large part of our work is advising students in all matters concerning their studies, such as study plans, but also social and legal matters.
